With the theme "Every sapling planted today tells the story of hope for generations to come," Fort's Root symbolises legacy, continuity, and growth, paralleling the journey of the club as it celebrates 10 years since recharter.

### **Project Planning**

Planning for Fort's Root began in March 2025, with the goal of completing two phases before the end of the Rotary quarter.

#### **Phase 1 – Trincomalee:**

- Partnered with the Rotaract Club of Trincomalee to identify suitable land
- Coordinated with local authorities to secure saplings and planting permission
- Conducted the planting in an open green estate with community involvement
- Educated younger community members on tree care

#### Phase 2 - Colombo:

- Identified semi-urban planting locations in partnership with estate caretakers
- Colombo Fort members personally contributed saplings and volunteered transport and planting tools

In total, **20 trees were planted** across both locations, marking the beginning of a project designed for long-term ecological impact.

### **Short-Term Impact:**

- Planted 20 trees across two cities
- Engaged two Rotaract clubs in hands-on environmental work
- Increased awareness among Rotaractors and locals on ecological responsibility

### **Long-Term Impact:**

- Contributed to increased green cover in both urban and semi-urban areas
- Built inter-club collaboration that could extend to future projects
- Enhanced visibility for the club's commitment to environmental service

### **Areas of Improvements**

- Earlier identification of planting zones could reduce logistical rush
- Greater local volunteer engagement for post-planting maintenance
- Future phases could include tree tagging and a digital map for tracking growth
