Project Planning

The **Safety First** project was meticulously planned over nearly two months, beginning on the **20th of September** and concluding on the **15th of November 2024**, ensuring that every detail was accounted for to achieve maximum impact.

1.

Initial Discussions & Conceptualization

- Date: 20th 25th September
- The core committee conducted brainstorming sessions to identify the most critical first-aid skills required by participants, focusing on life-saving techniques like CPR, wound care, and injury management.
- Host clubs (Rotaract Clubs of Colombo Fort, KDU, and NIBM) collaborated to finalize the project objectives and methodology.

Collaboration & Partnerships

- Timeline: 26th September 5th October
- Partnering with healthcare professionals and certified first-aid trainers to ensure quality content delivery.
- Logistics planning with venue coordinators to ensure accessibility and equipment setup at KDU premises.
- Coordination with the District Steering Committee for event support and participation alignment.

Content Development & Participant Registration

- Timeline: 6th October 20th October
- Development of educational materials (presentations, manuals, and quizzes) by the content team led by Muhammed and Miqdad.
- PR team facilitated registration drives targeting over **120 participants**, ensuring a mix of Rotaractors, sports directors, and outstation proxies.

Execution Plan

- Detailed agenda for theoretical and practical sessions prepared.
- $\circ\,$ Hands-on activities to ensure participants gained practical skills, with a scoring system motivating performance.
- Backup plans for online participation were devised for outstation attendees.

Final Preparations

- Date: 25th 27th October
- Logistics team ensured venue readiness with proper setup for demonstrations and participant seating.
- Administrative team ensured all registered participants received confirmation emails and instructions.
- PR content highlighting the importance of first-aid training shared across platforms to boost engagement.

Public Relations Plan

The **PR Plan** for **Safety First** was designed to create maximum visibility and engagement while respecting the sensitive nature of the event. The PR strategy highlighted the importance of first-aid knowledge as a life-saving skill and a critical community need.

Pre-Event Campaign

- A series of infographics and teaser videos were released, emphasizing the skills participants would learn, such as CPR and injury management.
- Content published by PR Coordinator **Yazeed**, with support from Nafeel, showcased testimonials from healthcare professionals endorsing the initiative.
- Email & WhatsApp Outreach
 - Targeted email campaigns reached club members, emphasizing the mandatory attendance requirement for sports directors.
 - Dedicated WhatsApp groups ensured streamlined communication with participants.

• Due to the nature of practical first-aid sessions, **photographs were strictly prohibited**, ensuring participants focused on learning without distractions.

• Social Media Highlights

• A single highlight reel showcasing the event's atmosphere and feedback from participants was shared post-event to maintain the element of exclusivity.

Post-Event PR

- Testimonials from participants and trainers were shared on social media platforms to demonstrate the program's impact.
- A concise post-event report was published online, summarizing the outcomes and thanking partners.
- Participants received digital certificates, reinforcing the credibility of the training.
